that they are required to

- **from 20th April 2026 to 19th May 2026:** submit a Graduation Application "Domanda di Laurea" via their **Uniweb** profile (for further info visit www.unipd.it/laurearsi);
- **on Monday, 29th June 2026 no later than 12:00 p.m.** send via email to the Segreteria Didattica of the Department of Biology, (didattica.biologia@unipd.it) and to the supervisor (Cc):
 - certificate of completion of master's degree internship (attestazione di conclusione di internato),
 - a copy of your thesis title page in PDF format.
- No later than **Monday, 29th June 2026 (12:00 p.m.)** upload an electronic file of your thesis work (**including the title page**) in PDF/A format (maximum size 40MB, file name Yoursurname_Yourgivenname.pdf) to the following platforms:
 - your **Uniweb profile**

IMPORTANT REMINDER: the deadline for the registration of all exams and activities is **15 days before** the date of graduation.

Characteristics of the Thesis

No more than 80 pages in total, including images, tables and bibliography:

- Abstract – up to 200 words;
- Bibliography – up to 35 references.

The thesis must be **original work**, based on personal study and/or research.

Drafting and editorial rules which must be strictly followed by all applicants:

The thesis must be in A4 sized paper format.

Use font size 12 with a total of 35 to 45 lines per page, setting the following page margins:

Inner margin 4 cm
Outer margin 3 cm
Upper margin 3 cm
Lower margin 2,5 cm

On the title page include all -and only- the information listed in the included example.

NOTICE: The title of the thesis approved by the supervisor in the online application and the title printed on the title page of the actual thesis must be **exactly** the same.

If needed, the title of the thesis can be modified by the Supervisor in the Uniweb system before the approval of the final version of the thesis attachment (PDF).
