## **Characteristics of the Thesis**

No more than 80 pages in total, including images, tables and bibliography:

- Abstract up to 200 words;
- Bibliography up to 35 references.

The thesis must be **original work**, based on personal study and/or research.

## <u>Drafting and editorial rules which must be strictly followed by all applicants:</u>

The thesis must be in A4 sized paper format.

Use font size 12 with a total of 35 to 45 lines per page, setting the following page margins:

Inner margin 4 cm Outer margin 3 cm Upper margin 3 cm Lower margin 2,5 cm

On the title page include all -and only- the information listed in the included example.

NOTICE: The title of the thesis approved by the supervisor in the online application and the title printed on the title page of the actual thesis must be **exactly** the same.
